is your opportunity to honor

loved one, to acknowledge
the loss, and to share the
process of saying goodbye.*

My intention in leading memorial services is to create an environment that allows you to be as relaxed and present as possible for this important event, leaving the logistics and details to me.

I offer two levels of service:

Level One

- ✧ I will lead a memorial service that fits the spiritual beliefs of you and your loved one. The ceremony can be spiritual, secular, or religious.
- ✧ You provide me with a short history that I will read.
- ✧ I will send you the outline ahead of the service, and you can include music, readings, and people to speak, and I will integrate these into the ceremony.
- ✧ We meet for an hour before the service to talk and go over the details.

A different option is that I can craft a memorial service that you can lead.

Level Two

- ✧ We meet in person or on Zoom so we can get acquainted and I can learn about the life of your beloved.
- ✧ I create a personalized memorial ceremony that is aligned with the nature and spiritual direction of your loved one as well as what is comfortable for you. The ceremony can be spiritual, secular, or religious.
- ✧ You write a short history of their life that includes significant events.

- ✧ I act as the "planner" for your ceremony, so you and your family can relax and be with the guests.
- ✧ I coordinate the sharing of memories by family and friends.
- ✧ I offer resources, and together we can plan appropriate readings or prayers, personalized rituals, and music, if desired.
- ✧ I offer suggestions for you to create a memorial program to hand out, if desired.

As an ordained minister through Centers for Spiritual Living, I am the community spiritual leader of the Center for Richer Living in Mill Valley, California, where we study the principles that are common among the major wisdom traditions.

My memorial services are mostly non-denominational. I treasure this work and find great satisfaction in being a source of comfort and support for families during this tender time of transition.
